

The BEST/VTmtss Summer Institute provides opportunities for school teams of educators, family members, and community stakeholders to share and learn strategies for improving and strengthening the systems, data, and practices within Vermont's expanded framework for enacting a multi-tiered system of supports (VTmtss). Learn about new programs, curricula, practices, and activities that emphasize positive, research-based strategies to support all students. Individual or team-attended strands and workshops are intentionally designed to complement afternoon school team planning sessions for building effective action plans.

Registration Information:

While individuals must attend the Institute as members of a school team, each person needs to
register separately. Once registration materials are posted online <i>March 5th</i> , each team
member <i>must</i> complete the online registration form by the due date, <i>April 5th</i> . Please identify
one member of your team to list as Team Leader on your individual registration form.
Deadline for individual registration is April 5 th or until the Institute is full. Registrations will be
accepted on a first-come, first-served basis, so encourage all team members to register early.
Individuals now have the ability to pay by credit card when they register. Invoices will be sent
no later than April 10th. Payment due date for all team members is May 10th. Registration will
only be confirmed once payment is received.
All outstanding balances owed to BEST/PBIS must be paid prior to confirming registration
(checks should be made out to UVM).
